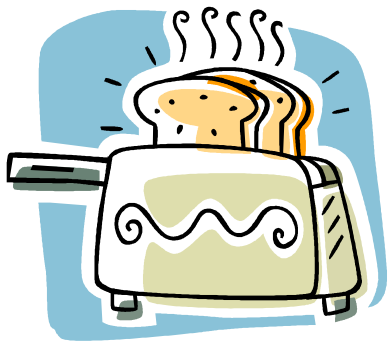

# Two Proposals



## Hillside Breakfast Program

- Hillside School 500+ students
- Truscott/Kelly area
- Grades 6-8
- High Economic Needs
- Breakfast Clubs of Canada (Government money) partially funds the program – rest donations
- 120+ students are given a hot breakfast daily
- Lunch program – totally self-funded
- Staffed by a teacher volunteer who does this in addition to her work day teaching Special Education

## Armagh House – Transition Program

- Second stage housing
  - Preparing women and families to return to independent living
  - Many women leave abusive situations with just what they can carry (often in a garbage bag)
1. Armagh was donated 3 computers for use by residents but there is no capacity for saving resumes/cover letters/application forms, etc. .
